Tomorrow, November 11, 2021, is Veterans Day.

Veterans Day, formerly known as Armistice Day, was originally a U.S. legal holiday to honor the end of World War I, which officially took place at the 11th hour on the 11th day of the 11th month of 1918.

This is not to be confused with Memorial Day, which honors those who died while in service,

After having been through both World War II and the Korean War, the 83rd U.S. Congress — with the urgings of the veterans' service organizations — amended the Act of 1938 by striking out the word 'Armistice' and adding the word 'Veterans.' They approved this legislation on June 1, 1954, which officially made November 11 a day to honor all American veterans who have served in the United States Armed Forces.

I would like to ask all of you to pause sometime during your day tomorrow and observe a moment of silence, with a special emphasis on our young men and women who are presently on active duty and deployed in harm's way around our globe.
